- 1. All the bids shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with the instructions as mentioned herein below. Any proposal which is not submitted in accordance with these instructions will be rejected without any further communication in this regard.
- 2. The Bid shall be submitted through the GeM (Government e-Marketplace) portal in TWO stages, namely:

 - b. Financial Bid

Technical Bid:

The Technical Bid shall contain the following documents, as specified in Section III, duly filled, signed, and stamped by authorized and accountable personnel only:

- Signed and Stamped Bid Document and tender document to be signed by authorized and accountable personnel only.
- Power of Attorney duly notarized, authorizing the individual signing the Bid on behalf of the Bidder.
- Details of EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) paid to AI Engineering Services Ltd online via payment gateway link provided in AIESL website (www.aiesl.in).

Important Note: No financial or price-related information shall be included in the Technical Bid. If any price or financial bid-related documents are found enclosed with



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the Technical Bid, AIESL reserves the right to summarily reject the entire Bid without any further consideration. No plea, representation, or clarification in this regard shall be entertained under any circumstances.

Financial Bid:

• The Financial Bid shall be submitted exclusively through the GeM (Government e-Marketplace) portal. The total value quoted for the works shall be considered for the purpose of evaluation and determination of the L1 (lowest) Bidder. The Financial Bid shall contain Annexure I (Financial Bid – BOQ): This must be duly completed, signed and stamped by the authorized representative of the Bidder.

- 12. Interested Bidders are strongly advised to visit the site and inspect the facilities and services to gain a comprehensive understanding of the scope of work before submitting their Bids.
- 13. All incidental costs related to execution of the work including but not limited to transportation, staff accommodation, canteen facilities, medical expenses, paid leave, annual increments, and bonuses for contract workers not covered under the Minimum Wages Act shall be borne by the Successful Bidder.
- 14. AIESL shall not be responsible for any such costs, and no payments beyond the quoted amount (based on actual work carried out) shall be made.



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Modification/ Withdrawal of Bids:

The Bidder may modify or withdraw their Bid after submission, strictly in accordance with the provisions and timelines permitted by the GeM portal.

Rejection of Bids:

Bids shall be rejected forthwith without further evaluation of the tender process under any of the following circumstances:

- 1. If the Bid has been submitted through any mode other than the GeM Portal, including but not limited to fax, email, physical submission, or courier.
- 2. If the Bid is unsigned or not duly authorized by the designated signatory.
- 3. If the Bid is submitted without the requisite EMD (Earnest Money Deposit).
- 4. If the Bid is found to be non-compliant with any disqualification or rejection criteria specified elsewhere in this Tender document.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Technical Bids:

The Technical Bids would be first evaluated for compliance. AIESL reserves the right at its sole discretion to seek whatever information, documents etc. from the bidder as it may consider necessary for the purpose of evaluation of the bids.

Price Bids:

The Price Bids of only those bidders who qualify as per the requirements of Technical Bid would be opened.

TERMINATION AND EXIT CLAUSE:

- 1. In case of unsatisfactory performance or breach of any of the clauses of this contract, AIESL would issue a notice of 30 days to the party to rectify the breach and improve the performance, failing which AIESL shall be at liberty to terminate this agreement by providing 30 days written notice to the party. The party shall not have any right to dispute or question the judgment of AIESL of the unsatisfactory performance of the party.
- 2. Notwithstanding the above, AIESL shall also be at liberty to terminate this agreement for any reason including change in situation/circumstances, etc. by providing the party with 90 days



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written notice. The party shall also be at liberty to terminate this contract by providing AIESL with 90 days written notice. In such an event, the terminating party shall have no right to claim compensation/damages, etc. from the terminating party on account of early termination. However, the party shall duly comply with their respective obligations during the notice period and thereafter, shall discharge the obligations arising out of the agreement till the termination.

PENALTY CLAUSE

If the CCTV system remain under breakdown for long period that is for 7 days (excluding breakdown of major critical component like CCTV storage server client pc) the contractor shall be liable pay damage (LD)/ penalty charges at the rate 0.5 % per week or subject to maximum of 10% of the work order contract value. This is to be recovered from the Security Deposit/ Performance Guarantee.

Benefits / Preference for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) and make in India Purchase Preference (MII):

- 1. Benefits and purchase preference will be given to MSEs as per Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs), Order, 2012 (Dated 23.03.2012).
- 2. Benefits and purchase preference will be given to Make in India as per Govt. of India policy.

Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/ Bid Security:

The Tenders shall be accompanied by proof of payment towards an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 18,650/-, paid online to AI Engineering Services Limited through payment gateway link: https://forms.eduqfix.com/aiengineering/add

Exemption of EMD:

The bidders seeking EMD exemption must submit the valid supporting documents for the relevant category with the Bid.

- 1. Micro and Small Enterprises whose credentials are validated online through Udyog Aadhaar.
- 2. Startups as recognized by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP).
- 3. Sellers who have got their credentials verified through the process of Vendor assessment by vendor Assessment Agencies for the particular product for which e-Bid/RA has been invited.
- 4. OEMs having annual turnover of Rs. 500 Cores and above and having profit in last three years out of five years.
- 5. MSEs/ MII units registered with the NSIC under its single point registration Scheme/Public Sector Registered with Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM).

Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee:

1. The Successful Bidder shall deposit with AIESL a Performance Security Deposit equivalent to 5% (five percent) of the total bid amount quoted for 02 years. This security deposit must be maintained throughout the contract period and shall be furnished in the form of a Bank Guarantee from a Nationalized or Scheduled Bank, in accordance with the standard format provided in Annexure – IV.



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- 2. Upon receipt of the Letter of Intent (LOI), the Successful Bidder shall deposit the Performance Security within fifteen (15) days of receiving the LOI.
- 3. The validity of Bank Guarantee would be till 60 days after the scheduled completion of all obligations under the Contract to the satisfaction of AIESL.
- 4. If the Performance Security Deposit is not submitted within the stipulated time or is not maintained at the required level throughout the contract period, the amount shall be recovered from the contractor's first or subsequent bills.
- 5. In the event of a breach of contract or violation of any terms and conditions of the agreement, AIESL reserves the right to invoke the Bank Guarantee.
- 6. All costs associated with the execution of the Bank Guarantee shall be borne by the Successful Bidder

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Scope of Work for Comprehensive AMC of CCTV Surveillance System

1. Overview

This Scope of Work (SOW) pertains to the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) for the CCTV Surveillance System installed at AI Engineering Services Ltd. (AIESL), MIHAN, SEZ, Nagpur.

The existing system is based on Hikvision Technology, comprising servers, storage, client systems, and allied equipment. The objective of this AMC is to ensure uninterrupted functionality, preventive maintenance, and prompt corrective action for all CCTV system components.

2. System Coverage

The AMC shall comprehensively cover all installed CCTV equipment, including but not limited to:

- All CCTV Cameras (IP/Dome/PTZ) Total 43 Nos.
- Network Video Recorders (NVRs)
- Storage Devices (Enterprise-grade HDDs, NAS, SAN as applicable)
- Client Systems
- Touchscreen Joysticks
- Control Room Equipment (Complete Client System)
- Power Supply Units of CCTV Cameras (SMPS / Adapters)

3. Scope of Services

3.1 Preventive Maintenance

- Scheduled preventive maintenance visits (Minimum quarterly).
- Cleaning of cameras, lenses, and recording devices.
- Inspection of cables, connectors, and terminations.
- Licensed Firmware/software updates and patches for NVR/DVR/VMS (Hikvision-compatible)
- Health check of storage devices and backup verification.
- Testing of power supply units/adapter
- Calibration/adjustment of camera angles and focus.

3.2 Corrective Maintenance / Breakdown Support

- Unlimited breakdown calls during AMC period.
- On-site response within 24 hours of complaint.
- Supply & Replacement of faulty components (Hikvision Tech based only) including:
 - a. CCTV cameras (PTZ & Dome) 8 mp, 48x Zoom Hikvision make having same or higher specification and compatible with existing system
 - b. CCTV HP Server



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- c. NVR system Hikvision Tech based
- d. Storage Server
- e. Enterprises Grade HDDs
- f. Touch Screen Joysticks
- g. Complete Client System
- h. Computer system
- i. Media Converters
- Provision of temporary standby equipment in case of major repairs.

3.3 Remote Support (From Hikvision Tech)

- Remote monitoring and troubleshooting through VPN/secure access.
- System alerts and proactive support for downtime reduction.
- Support for HikCentral License

4. Spares & Repairs

- All spare parts, components, and consumables shall be included in AMC cost (Comprehensive AMC).
- Only consumables such as LAN cables, connectors, Network/POE switches and fiber cables shall be excluded and remain in AIESL's scope.

5. Reporting & Documentation

- Maintenance visit reports after each service.
- Breakdown/ rectification reports with details of faults and corrective measures.
- Quarterly performance reports highlighting uptime, downtime, and preventive actions taken.

6. Service Levels & Response Time

- Response time: Within [24 hours] of logging complaint.
- Resolution time: Within [7 days] depending on severity.

7. Exclusions (if any)

- Physical damages due to fire, flood, theft, or force majeure events.
- Electrical issues beyond the CCTV system's dedicated supply line.
- Supply & Installation of Additional CCTV cameras in the same system.

8. General Terms

- The contractor shall depute qualified service engineers.
- All maintenance activities shall be carried out in coordination with AIESL's security/IT department.
- Access to restricted areas shall be taken with prior approval.
