INTRODUCTION

AI Engineering Services Ltd. has been incorporated under the Indian Companies Act 1956. AI Engineering Services Ltd. is an Aviation MRO and fully owned Company of Government of India which provides maintenance, repair and related support for fleets of aircraft of Govt. organizations as well as commercial domestic and international airlines.

This RFQ is issued to invite proposals from reputed Service Providers with credible experience in Operation and Maintenance of Demineralized Water (DM) Plant CAMC /AMC for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water Plant of State/Central Government department, State/Central Govt. PSUs, hospitality industry or large public organizations in conformance of specifications given in the tender documents and distribute the same at various locations in India as per requirement and schedule.



General Terms & Conditions:

Quotations in Single Packet basis are invited for the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water Plant- JEOC, AI Engineering Services Limited, IGI Airport, New Delhi.

1. Interested and eligible vendors are requested to submit their quotations through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal.
2. You are requested to submit your lowest quotations as applicable to Government Department/Public Sector Undertaking & Government Hospitals/Institutions and also advise MRP.
3. Duly filled quotations should be submitted in GEM within the stipulated time.
4. Rates shall be quoted as per Commercial Bid format (Annexure 5).
5. The Tenderer shall ensure that no damage is caused to AIESL property/ or any decorative structure/ fittings, while carrying out the work. The Tenderer will have to rectify/ make good such damages at their cost.
6. Service Provider has to arrange safety/ protective equipment at its own cost.
7. Purchase Order will be placed on lowest quote basis.
8. Payment Terms: Payment will be released within **30 days** from the date of receipt of the invoice.
9. Billing Cycle: -Monthly
10. EMD (Earnest Money Deposit): - Nil
11. Statutory deduction like income tax and other applicable taxes shall be deducted at source from each payment of the Tenderer.
12. Validity: - Your rates should be valid for a period of 120 days
13. Grounds for Rejection of Bids:
 - a) Bids should be **neatly presented**. Any corrections must be **duly authenticated** with the full signature of the authorized signatory; otherwise, the bid will be rejected.
 - b) All relevant **supporting documents** attached with the bids must be **duly signed** by the bidder. Incomplete documentation may lead to rejection.
 - c) Bids **not signed by the authorized signatory** will be rejected.
 - d) Bids submitted via **email will not be accepted**.
 - e) **Unsigned or incomplete** Technical and/or Commercial Bids will be rejected.
 - f) If either the **Technical Bid or Commercial Bid is not received**, the tender will be considered invalid.
 - g) **Conditional bids** (Technical or Commercial) will not be accepted and shall be rejected.
 - h) Bids **not meeting the eligibility criteria** specified in the tender will be rejected during technical evaluation.

14. PENALTY CLAUSE/LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

- a) Unless otherwise notified in the tender, the penalty to be levied for delayed delivery would be @ 0.5% per week or part thereof of the value of the undelivered portion of the goods or services (excluding taxes and delivery charges) subject to a maximum of 10% of the value of the undelivered or delayed goods. This is to be recovered from the Security Deposit / Performance Guarantee, or from the amount due to the vendor after due

notification to the vendor in advance.

15. The contractor/ successful bidder shall abide by the legal provision with regard to health, welfare and safety of persons engaged by him as per factory act and rules. The contractor/ successful bidder shall also be responsible for medical care of their personnel engaged. Ex-gratia / bonus leave salary, retrenchment benefits etc. under statutory levies shall be paid by the contractor/ successful bidder to their personnel as per bonus act / other rules at his own cost. No extra payments shall be made by AI Engineering Services Limited in this regard.

16. The contractor/ successful bidder shall be responsible for the compliance of all the rules and regulations of the following prevailing acts of Govt. of India/ Govt. of Delhi:

- a. Factory Act.
- b. Minimum Wages Act.

- d. Bonus Act.
- e. Contract Labors (Regulation & Abolition) Act as prevalent and the rules and regulations made therein from time to time

16. Benefits/Preference for Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) & Start-ups:

16.1 As per Public Procurement Policy for Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) Order, 2012 issued vide Gazette Notification No. 503 dated 23.03.2012 by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises of Govt. of India, MSEs must be registered with any of the following in order to avail the benefits/preference available vide Public Procurement Policy MSEs Order, 2012.

- (a) District Industries Centres (DIC)
- (b) Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)
- (c) Khadi and Village Industries Board
- (d) Coir Board
- (e) National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)
- (f) Directorate of Handicraft and Handloom
- (g) Any other body specified by Ministry of MSME

16.2 MSEs participating in the tender must submit the certificate of registration with any one of the above agencies indicating the details of the particular tendered item along with their bid.

16.3 The MSEs registered with District Industries Centers must submit the 'Acknowledgement of Entrepreneur Memorandum (EM) Part-II' along with their bid. The MSMEs registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) must submit the valid NSIC registration certificate along with their bid.

16.4 The Micro & Small Enterprises not registered for the particular trade/item for which the tender is relevant, would not be eligible for exemption/preference. The registration certificate issued from any one of the above agencies must be valid as on close date of the tender. The successful bidder should ensure that the same is valid till the end of the contract period.

16.5 The MSEs who have applied for registration or renewal of registration with any of the above agencies/ bodies, but have not obtained the valid certificate as on close date of the tender, are not eligible for exemption/preference.

16.6 The successful Bidder will be required to submit the Security Deposit equivalent to 5% of the Contract/PO value.

16.7 In alignment with Government policies promoting the participation of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs), the following exemption and purchase preference have been incorporated into the tender document:

- 1) MSEs are exempted from the requirement of submitting the EMD as per applicable guidelines.

- 2) Purchase Preference – As this is a service contract that cannot be divided and awarded in parts to multiple parties, any MSE quoting within L1 + 15% and agreeing to match the L1 price shall be considered for award of the entire tendered value

Note: The above MSE purchase preference (2) will not be considered if the MSE certificate pertains to an experience category other than that specified in the tender requirements i.e., CAMC/AMC for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water Plant.

16.8 Startup firms possessing a valid Certificate of Recognition issued by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) shall be eligible for relaxation in turnover and prior experience requirements, as per applicable government guidelines.

The relaxations are as follows:

1. Startups are exempted from the requirement of submitting the EMD as per applicable guidelines
2. Experience Requirement: must have a minimum of two years instead of three years starting 01-04-2022 in providing CAMC/AMC for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water Plant To avail these relaxations, eligible bidders must upload a valid DPIIT registration certificate issued by DPIIT.
3. Turnover Requirement: Relaxed by 25%. DPIIT-recognized startups shall be required to have a minimum average annual turnover of Rs. 1,00,000/- instead of Rs. 1,50,000/- (Mandatory)

16.9 Relaxations and Exemptions for SC/ST Bidders (MSEs)

1. Exemption from EMD: SC/ST Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) are exempted from payment of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
2. Purchase Preference: In case the L1 bidder is a non-MSE and MSE bidders quote within L1 + 15%, the purchase preference shall be given in the following order, subject to matching the L1 price:
 - i. First Preference: SC/ST & Women MSEs
 - ii. Second Preference: SC/ST MSEs
 - iii. Third Preference: Women MSEs
 - iv. Fourth Preference: Other MSEs

Note: Since the tender is for services (indivisible in nature), the entire order will be awarded to the eligible MSE bidder who matches the L1 price.

3. Multiple L1 Bidders: In case two or more bidders are evaluated as L1, preference shall be given in the following order:

- i. SC/ST & Women MSEs
- ii. SC/ST MSEs
- iii. Women MSEs

16.10 The contractor/ successful bidder shall be responsible for the compliance of all the rules and regulations of the prevailing MSE acts specified by Ministry of MSME and the changes made from time to time.

17. TERMINATION AND EXIT CLAUSES: -

The PO / contract should include a termination clause as below:

1. In case of unsatisfactory performance or breach of any of the clauses of this contract, AIESL would issue a notice of 30 days to the party to rectify the breach and improve the performance failing which AIESL shall be at liberty to terminate this agreement by providing 30 days written notice to the party. The party shall not have any right to dispute or question the judgment of AIESL of unsatisfactory performance of the party.
2. Notwithstanding the above, AIESL shall also be at liberty to terminate this agreement for any reason including change in situation/circumstances, etc. by providing to the party 90

days written notice. The party shall also be at liberty to terminate this contract by providing to AIESL 90 days written notice. In such an event, the terminated party shall have no right to claim compensation/damages, etc. from the terminating party on account of early termination. However, the party shall duly comply with their respective obligations during the notice period and thereafter, shall discharge the obligations arising out of the agreement till the termination.

3. Depending on the nature of the item / service, DGM - Engineering and above, in consultation with the user, would be the competent authority to decide the termination / exit period if it varies from the above.
18. It is the responsibility of the Service Provider/bidder to ensure that they comply with all the rules and regulations legal /statutory agencies. Al Engineering Services Limited shall be indemnified from any legal action, in case of any violation by the Service Provider/bidder.
19. In case of any disputes, Decision of Dy.GM (E-PPMM) will be the final and binding.
20. Al Engineering Services limited, reserve the right to cancel the tender without assigning any reason. Dispute resolution and arbitration Any dispute arising between the Bidder/Successful Bidder and AIESL in respect of the construction, interpretation, application, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this document or the validity or breach thereof, shall first be settled by negotiations between the authorized representatives of the Bidder/Successful Bidder and AIESL (Parties). If the dispute remains unresolved after a period of 90 days from the date when the negotiation has started, then the unresolved dispute/difference shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be final and binding on the Parties. The arbitral tribunal shall consist of a sole arbitrator to be mutually appointed by the Parties. The venue of arbitration shall be Delhi and the arbitration proceedings shall be carried out in English. The cost of the arbitration shall be borne by the Parties as per the award of the Sole Arbitrator
21. Jurisdiction:

The construction, interpretation, validity and performance of this Tender and/or Contract shall be governed by the laws of India. Any dispute whatsoever, arising out of or in connection with the Tender and/or Contract shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Delhi only, subject to the clause of dispute resolution and arbitration aforesaid.

22. Grievance Redressal Mechanism

- a) "Any supplier, contractor, or consultant that claims to have suffered or is likely to suffer loss or injury as a result of a decision/ action/ omission of the Procurement Entity may make an application for its review within a period of Five (5) days from its date (as applicable), to Dy GM-PPMM, specifying the ground(s) and the relevant clauses of the tender documents. Unsuccessful Bidders may seek de-briefing regarding the rejection of their bid, in writing or electronically, within Five (5) days of the declaration of techno-commercial or financial evaluation results."
- b) Only directly affected and participating bidders can raise a grievance.

Grievances can be raised only for the stage in which the bidder is eligible: After pre-qualification: Only pre-qualified bidders may raise issues about technical/financial bids. After technical evaluation: Only technically qualified bidders may raise issues about financial bids.

Work Scope for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water Treatment Plant

1.0 Work Scope and Working Hours for day-to-day Operation of DM Water Treatment Plant:

1.1 Deployment of Operation:

The contractor has to deploy a qualified and trained operator to operate the DM Water Treatment Plant located at JEOP, IGIA, T-2, New Delhi-110037. The qualification and training of the operator should be as per Industry Norms.

1.2 Working Hours:

- i) The Normal working Hrs of AIESL establishments/ shops are six days a week between 08.15 to 16.15 hrs (Monday to Saturday) except for Holidays/ Sundays. Accordingly, plant operations shall be required as per above working hours.
- ii) In case of any requirement of plant operations on Holidays/ Sundays, OR after 1615 hrs on any working day, AIESL shall intimate the contractor in writing for same and the contractor shall have to make arrangements without any extra cost to AIESL.

2.0 Work scope for CAMC for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water Treatment Plant:

2.1 INVENTORY OF DM WATER TREATMENT PLANT.

2.2 Work Scope for Water Treatment in D.M. Water Treatment Plant:

- i) Water Treatment will be carried out AIESL premises in the existing D.M. Water Plant.
- ii) Treatment Plant to meet the following standard/ specifications:

Specifications for Treated water from CA outlet
Treated water from CA outlet must confirm to

 - (a) Ph = 7.5 to 8.5
 - (b) Elect, Conductivity # below 30 micro-Siemens Cm-1
 - (c) TDS# less than 5PPM

Specifications for Treated water from MB outlet
Treated water from MB outlet must confirm to

 - (a) Ph = 6.8 to 7.2
 - (b) Elect, Conductivity: below 1 micro SiemensCm-1
 - (c) TDS = less than 1PPM
- iii) The minimum requirement of Treated Water is 10,000 Ltrs per month. If minimum requirement is not met, penalty clause will be implemented

3. Operation of DM Water Treatment Plant will be done by the contractor in all aspects including manpower and consumable chemicals/ material etc.
4. Preventive maintenance schedule will be given by the contractor on monthly basis at the beginning of the month latest by the tenth day of the month.
5. Inlet raw water to the CA unit should be tested / analysed every quarter and efficiency of CA unit and MB unit should be judged accordingly.
6. Every quarter, physico-Chemical Analysis/ Testing of raw water (input), CA treated outlet water and MB treated outlet water shall be arranged by the contractor in approved analytical laboratory and this arrangement will be initiated within first day of each quarter. If any sample falls in any parameter, corrective action shall be initiated by the contractor without any delay and retesting thereof shall be carried out successfully, till the sample passed the required parameter.
7. You will fully bear the testing and or/re-testing charge as mentioned above. You will also take all action so as to avoid any adverse action by any Govt./Water agency on AIESL with regard to pollution Control Water Quality Management.
8. Routine Physico-Chemical testing of various water samples shall be carried out in respect of the following parameters in general.
 - (a) Physical Test shall include # appearance, odour, pH Value, Turbidity (NT u), Conductivity (Ms Cm-1 at 25°C)
 - (b) Chemical Testing shall include total dissolved Solids
 - i) Phenolphthalein alkalinity (as Ca Co₃)
 - ii) Total M.O. alkalinity (as Ca Co₃)
 - iii) Total Hardness (as Ca Co₃), parameter hardness (as Ca Co₃)
 - iv) Temporary Hardness (as Ca Co₃)
 - v) Calcium Hardness (as Ca Co₃), Magnesium Hardness (as Ca Co₃)
 - vi) Silica (as Ca Co₃), Dissolved iron (as Fe), Sulphates (as So₄).
9. The contractor shall submit and arrange all consumable chemicals such as Caustic Soda and Hydrochloric Acid for use in DM Water Treatment Plant. AIESL will however provide storage Space for these chemical and items near water treatment plant.
10. Periodic Service of the Plant:
 - i) Service Engineer (s) of the contractor will also check media quantities/ quality quarterly and initiate step required for topping up of necessary media and items. These media and items shall be arranged/ provided by AIESL and be replaced by the contractor without any extra labour cost to AIESL.
 - ii) In case, these items are not provided by AIESL, the same shall be provided by the contractor on cost basis and
 - iii) replaced without any extra labour charge to AIESL. However, decision of AIESL in this regard shall be Final.

11. Testing/ Calibration of various gauges and instrument e.g., Conductivity Meter, any Ph meter, Pressure Gauge, Flow Meter etc. installed and associated with the DM Water Treatment Plant is to be done every 6 months by the contractor at his own cost.
12. The expenditure required for replacement of 'MAJOR' Component(s) shall be borne by AIESL.
13. The contractor will have to bear the cost of Rs.2000/- Per Month in case if there is any repair of Minor Components/ consumable parts like nut, bolt, gaskets, valves of low cost etc and repairing of plastic/ metallic PIPELINE etc. on priority. In case if the cost of above-mentioned spares is more than Rs.2000/- C Per month, then AIESL will bear the expenses (whenever required) subject to prior approval from DGM (E- Repair) or his authorized person.
14. The contractor/ operator will have to submit a detailed Monthly/ Fort nightly report of DM Plant to the DGM (E-Repair), JEOC. or to his nominee.
15. Serviceability status of the DM Water Treatment Plant will be given by the contractor to DGM (ENGG) every 3 months i.e., every quarter.
16. Preventive Maintenance: i) Apart from the, continuous operation of the plant by the operator, qualified Service Engineer of the contractor will perform periodic visits (twice a month) to provide trouble shooting, breakdown services and calibration of gauges/ instruments. ii) Plant to be cleaned thoroughly on regular basis as well as paints of the plant to be carried out once in a year.
17. Cleaning of 'Sintex' Water Storage Tank to be done every 3 months positively.

TECHNICAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The bidder must have at least three years' experience starting 01-04-2022 for providing similar services to Central/State Government/ PSUs/ Nationalized Banks/ Reputed Organizations. Services rendered with duration and the name of the organization shall be furnished (As per list of experience- Annexure 1). **(MANDATORY)**.
2. The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years starting from 01-04-2022 i.e., the current financial year and the last three financial years, meeting any of the following criteria. **(MANDATORY):**
 - a) Three similar works, each with value of not less than INR 1,99,762 /- of the estimated cost **(Mandatory)**
 - or
 - b) Two similar works, each with value of not less than INR 2,49,703/- **(Mandatory)**
 - Or
 - c) One similar work with value of not less than INR 3,99,524/- **(Mandatory)**.

3. Service provider shall maintain the DM water Plant as per prescribed scope of work in Annexure -1 and document the same on all its service reports.
4. Whether Tenderer having average Annual Turnover of Rs.1,50,000 /-(Rupees One Lakh fifty thousand only) or above for each financial year 2022-23, 2023-2024 & 2024-25. Self-attested Copies of Balance sheet, Profit & Loss A/C in support of above are enclosed. **(MANDATORY)**.
5. The work shall be carried out in such a manner so as to cause minimum disturbance to working of AIESL.
6. Any loss of material or damage to equipment due to negligence during the work shall be recovered from the contractor.
7. AIESL shall not be responsible for any injury sustained to the contractor's personnel during the repair work.
8. Service provider should have a working office in Delhi/NCR.
9. Service provider should provide the copy of PF and ESIC Certificate.
10. Service provider should provide the copy of GSTIN Certificate & PAN CARD. **(MANDATORY)**
11. Service provider should provide self-attested copies of ITR Returns for the three financial years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25. **(MANDATORY)**.
- 12. PERIOD OF CONTRACT- ONE YEAR**
- 13. Turn Over Certificate certified by CA for financial years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 enclosed (MANDATORY)**

UNDER TAKINGS: (To be agreed and signed by the tenderer)

- 1) Confirmed that all the provisions of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and rules made there under shall be complied with. In particular, if the said Act is applicable to us, we shall obtain the required licenses under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act 1970 from the concerned Labour Authorities within 15 days of obtaining LOA as the case may be at our own cost and initiative and deposit a copy with AI Engineering Services Ltd. at the time of commencement of the work.
- 2) Confirmed that the complete Work of C AMC for Operation and Maintenance of DM Water plant as per the Work Scope (Annexure-1) given in the Tender Enquiry shall be operational within 30 days from the date of acceptance of Letter Of Award (LOA).
- 3) Confirmed that the registrations and licenses under all the applicable local and central taxes and laws and to be specified separately under each applicable tax/law/Act (i.e., GST /Work Contract Act/Provident Fund Act/ESI Act/Income Tax Act/Shop & Establishment Act etc.) shall be produced for verification/checking of AI Engg. Services Ltd. Or to a third party authorized by AI Engg. Services Ltd. / Agencies of Govt. of India.
