Contract period will be for two years further extendable by another one year on the same terms and conditions after successful completion of the contract subjected to mutual agreement by both parties.

L-1 will be decided on the least cost basis.

4. WORK SCOPE:

The selected hospital / Facilitator shall provide the following services at AIESL TRV MRO premises:
In case of facilitator/agency, a valid MoU/tie-up with a registered hospital with in 10 km vicinity of our premises is mandatory.

4.1 Deployment of Medical Personnel

- a) **One qualified MBBS Doctor** (minimum MBBS degree from a recognized Indian University approved by the Medical Council of India/National Medical Commission, with valid registration from the State Medical Council and minimum two years of experience as a medical practitioner) shall be deployed from **Monday to Saturday, 09:00 AM to 06:00 PM.**
- b) **Qualified Staff Nurse(s)** (Registered Nurse having completed a three-year course in General Nursing from a School of Nursing or institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council, or B.Sc. Nursing with valid registration) shall be deployed from **Monday to Sunday, including holidays, from 06:00 AM to 10:45 PM.**
- c) The hospital shall ensure provision of reliever/substitute staff in case of leave, absence, or any exigency, without interruption of services.
- d) **The duty timings may be revised/modified based on AIESL operational requirements, if required, without additional financial implications, subject to mutual agreement.**

4.2 Occupational Health Services

- a) Provide first aid and primary medical care for occupational injuries and illnesses.
- b) Maintain medical records and treatment registers as per statutory requirements.
- c) Conduct annual general medical checkup for the employees of AIESL
- d) Assist in periodic medical examinations and health surveillance programs.
- e) Provide medical advice related to workplace health hazards.
- f) Coordinate emergency referral and ambulance services whenever required.

4.3 Breath Analyzer (BA) Testing

- a) Conduct BA testing for minimum 25% of eligible MRO personnel on daily basis as per DGCA mandate.
- b) Deploy minimum two calibrated and DGCA-compliant Breath Analyzer equipment with valid calibration certificates.
- c) Maintain proper BA testing records, registers, and reports as per DGCA requirements.
- d) Ensure confidentiality and integrity of BA test records.
- e) Submit daily/monthly BA testing reports to authorized MRO representative.
- f) Provide standby BA equipment to avoid disruption of testing activities.
- g) Ensure immediate reporting of positive cases to authorized management representative as per laid down procedure.



4.4 Duties & Responsibilities of Doctor and Staff Nurse

- a. Doctor and Staff Nurse to meet and follow the Medical Requirement as per Kerala Industrial Factory Act 1948.
- b. Doctor and Staff Nurse to meet and follow the DGCA Requirement as stated in CAR Section 5 Series F Part IV.
- c. Doctor and Staff Nurse to carry out Breath Analyser test as per DGCA CAR Requirement in CAR Section 5 Series F Part IV for AIESL BMD & LMD staff or any other contracted organisation by AIESL Trivandrum working in the premises i.e for at least 25% employees working for AIESL Trivandrum, are randomly subjected to breath-analyser examination on a daily basis, when they report for the duty.
- d. Doctor to inform AIESL official for maintaining minimum and mandatory medicine requirement in Medical Room and in First Aid Kit.
- e. Doctor to certify First Aid Kit in AIESL Trivandrum premises.
- f. Doctor and Staff Nurse to handle any emergency case in AIESL TRIVANDRUM Premises and if required, direct them to the hospital.
- g. Medical consultation by Doctor for staff working in AIESL Trivandrum.
- h. Medical Certification for renewal of DGCA or Regulatory Licenses of Organisation and AME License Renewal.
- i. Assessment for Fatigue in terms of Human Factor duty time limitations.
- j. Any other responsibility of a Doctor as required from time to time may be assigned by AIESL in consultation with the hospital

4.5 Breath Analyzer (BA) Equipment Requirements

1. BA equipment shall meet DGCA specifications as per DGCA CAR Section 5 Series F Part IV Issue I Rev 1 dated 8th April 2024.
2. The hospital shall make available at least two serviceable BA equipment fuel cell technology based, capable of giving accurate digital value up to three decimal places in % BAC. The equipment shall have a memory to store and recall at least last 1000 records.
3. The BA equipment shall be used only in auto /active mode.
4. The BA equipment shall be attachable to a printer. At least one serviceable printer for the BA equipment shall be available at all times.
5. BA equipment shall have valid and traceable calibration certificate.
6. The BA equipment shall be calibrated after 10,000 blows/at a frequency as recommended by the equipment manufacturer whichever is earlier from an agency having ISO/NABL certification. The date of the last calibration shall be appended on the instrument. Record of such calibrations shall be maintained by the HOSPITAL. It shall be the responsibility of the HOSPITAL / agency to ensure continued serviceability of the BA equipment and maintain such records.
7. Adequate mouthpieces and consumables shall be supplied by the vendor.
8. The service provider shall ensure periodic calibration and preventive maintenance of BA equipment.

5 . INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER (ITB)

Bidders shall submit their offer and should upload the relevant documents on GEM Portal for further evaluation.

Bid opening procedure for bidders:

- a- Part-I Technical Bids shall be opened on GEM PORTAL and will be evaluated for establishing eligibility of the bidder as well as techno-commercial responsiveness as per bid conditions.
- b- The Part-II Financial Bid will be opened of only those Bidder(s), who are found to be meeting the eligibility criteria or technically qualified.
- c- Bidders will be informed through GEM for every step. No separate mail and communication will be done by AIESL.
- d- **Cancellation/ Disqualification of bids:**
 - i- The bids should be neatly presented. No overwriting or cutting/usage of white correction ink would be accepted in the Tender Document. Corrections, if any, should be duly stamped with full signature of the authorized person who is signing the Tender, failing which the Tender is liable to be rejected.
 - ii- If the bidder submitted financial bid with technical bid.
 - iii- Tender documents received without signed, stamped and blank fields.

AIESL reserves the right to award the contract(s) to Successful Bidder as it may deem fit as per its operational requirements.

6 COMMERCIAL TERMS & CONDITONS

A. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):

Non-Compliance on EMD terms will lead to disqualification.

- i) An Earnest Money Deposit of **Rs.67,000/-** must be submitted through the payment gateway available on our AIESL portal. Click on the option displayed on the AIESL home page (aiesl.in) – "For making any payments click here" and payment details shall be submitted along with the technical bid.
- ii) EMD will not carry any interest.
- iii) EMD in respect of successful bidder will be adjusted against Security Deposit.
- iv) If above, bid received without EMD or lesser amount of EMD or received in different mode, will be rejected.
- v) In case, the selected bidder refuses to accept the LOA/Contract OR fails to abide by any terms of the Tender/fails to commence the work within stipulated time, EMD shall be forfeited

- vii) In the case of unsuccessful bidders, EMD shall be refunded without interest, within a reasonable time (30 Days) after finalization of the Tender (L-1 Party).

EXEMPTION FROM EMD

- i) As per Govt of India Gazette Notification No. 5031, dated 26.3.2012, MSME's registered with District Industries Centres / KVIC's/ KVIB's/ Coir Board/ NSIC/Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or any other body specified by Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), are exempted from payment of EMD. Valid certificate of registration with as above, must be provided by the bidder(s) seeking exemption of EMD. Public Sector units/Central/State Govt. undertakings/units registered with central purchase organization (eg. DGS&D) will be exempted from submission of EMD. Certificate is to be attached with technical bid as proof of exemption.
- ii) Bidder must be registered with the same services in MSE to claim the exemption.

B. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- i) The successful bidder / hospital shall submit 5% of the total contract value as Security Deposit.
- ii) The bidder who qualifies for the award of contract, The EMD amount will be converted as SD.
- iii) The Security Deposit will be refunded after 60 days of successful completion of contract period after adjustment of penalties, if any, that may be imposed under the terms & conditions of the contract.
- iv) SD amount will not bear any interest.
- v) SD can be given as Bank Guarantee format from any reputed Bank.

7 SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS (STC):

- i) Quotations should be submitted on or before the closing date and time.
- ii) Bidder to sign each document which he is uploading on GEM portal. Unsigned Bid documents are liable to be rejected.
- iii) The Bids should be neatly presented. Corrections, if any, should be duly authenticated with full signature of the person who has signed the Bids, failing which such Bids are liable to be rejected.
- iv) AIESL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reason.
- v) In the event of default in services, AIESL reserves the right to cancel the order and to claim damages from the successful tenderer, and also reserves the right to award the contract to another vendor at the cost and risk of the successful bidder.
- vi) AIESL shall make payment by Electronic Transfer of funds within 45 days on submission of bills duly certified by the officer authorized by user department.
- vii) Deduction of Govt. taxes at source shall be done by AIESL as per Govt. rules applicable from time to time.



A. PENALTY CLAUSE:

Prompt, Punctual, Efficient, Safe, Courteous and Quality Service is the Essence of this PO. In case of failure on the part of the service provider to comply with any one or more of the terms of the PO, the applicable penalty clauses listed below shall be invoked.

0.5% of the PO value per week to a maximum of 10% of the total value will be levied for non-completion of satisfactory performance of the work within the stipulated period.

B PRICE NEGOTIATION

As it is not the general norm for AIESL to carry out price negotiations following evaluation of the bids (NIT), the bidders are advised to submit their best quotes in response to this tender. However, AIESL reserves the right to carry out negotiations in exceptional cases with the bidder who has been evaluated by AIESL as having offered the lowest bid in response to the tender.

C. VALIDITY OF PRICES:

Quotations should be valid for a period of **120 days** from the opening of the bid.

D. EXIT CLAUSE/TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT:

The service provider shall undertake that in the event of failure to complete the job within the time and according to the requirement and the terms & conditions of the PO, the PO will be liable for cancellation and services will be obtained from other sources on account and at the cost-of-service provider. The service provider will be fully responsible for any difference in rate and other expenses arising out of such alternate arrangement.

E. REJECTION OF BIDS:

The response to the Bidder will be rejected forthwith without evaluation of the tender response on the following grounds:

- i. If not signed all tender document and submitted/uploaded along with technical bid
- ii. If the Bidder have been received after due date and time of closing of the tender.
- iii. If the BID has been received by fax or email.
- iv. If the BID has been received unsigned.
- v. The Bidder should ensure that: -
 - The bid document should be neatly typed and signed/approved on numbered pages filed in binding manner.
 - Corrections/over writing, if any, should be duly authenticated with full signature of the person who is signing the tender (initials will not be accepted).
- vi. **If, bids received incomplete in any manner of without relevant self-certified documents.**

F. ARBITRATION:

Any dispute arising between the parties in respect of the construction, interpretation, application, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this document or the validity or breach thereof, shall first be settled by mutual consultation. If the dispute remains unresolved after a period of 90 days from the date when the mutual consultation has started, the matter shall be referred for settlement to 'SCOPE FORUM OF CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION', Govt. of India, and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties.

G. FRAUDULENT PRACTICES:

AIESL requires that Bidders observe the highest standard of ethics during the Bidding process and execution of contracts. In pursuance of this, AIESL defines, for the purposes of

this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

- a) “Corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- b) “Fraudulent practice” means a misrepresentation of facts to influence a procurement process, or the execution of a contract deemed to be detrimental to AIESL and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive AIESL of the benefits of free and open competition.
- c) EMD or Security deposit shall be forfeited in addition to the above-mentioned remedies which AIESL shall have taken.

H. **BLACK LISTING CONDITIONS:**

The party shall be blacklisted from participating in any AIESL tenders for next three years in case adopts fraudulent practices as cited above in clause and against errant bidders as specified in clause. Withdraws after award of the Purchase order / Letter Of Award (LOA) and fails to commence within the specified stipulated period and perform the contractual obligations during the currency of the Purchase order.

I. **INTERPRETATION OF AMBIGUITY:**

If the contractor needs any clarification as to the scope of the “agreement”, and other conditions of contract, the contractor is at liberty to get them clarified before quoting tender rates.

J. **FORCE MAJEURE:**

Neither party shall be liable for delay in performing obligations or for failure to perform obligations if the delay results from any of the following (whether happening in India or elsewhere) force majeure, Act of God or any Governmental act, fire, earthquake, explosion, accident, industrial dispute, civil commotion, or anything beyond the control of either party. The party shall use all reasonable endeavors to minimize any such delay. Upon cessation of the event giving rise to the delay the parties shall in so far as may be practicable under the circumstance

K. **JURISDICTION**

Any dispute whatsoever shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of New Delhi, India, only.

L. **PAYMENT TERMS (Non acceptance by the Bidder on Payment terms will lead to disqualification)**

Payment shall be released within 45 days of submission of invoice on satisfactory services as per TABLE 1. No advance payments request is accepted.
