4.4.1 Bid opening procedure for bidders:

Sealed bids will opened as per time schedule mentioned herein this tender document.

Bidder(s) can view Bid opening event in person or over online call at their end. In the event of the Specified date for the opening of bids being declared a holiday for AIESL, the Bids will be opened at the appointed time and location on the next working day.

Technical Bids (i.e., Part-I) shall be opened first.

Part-I i.e., Technical Bids shall be evaluated for establishing eligibility of the bidder as well as techno-commercially responsiveness as per bid conditions, and a list will be drawn up of the responsive bids whose financial bids are eligible for consideration.

The Part-II i.e. Financial Bid of only of those Bidder(s), who are found to be meeting the eligibility criteria as well as techno-commercially responsive for the subject Works shall be opened thereafter. The date of opening of the Financial Bid shall be notified separately to all the eligible & techno-commercial responsive Bidder.

4.4.5 Disqualified Bids

Price Bids of the technically disqualified Bidders would be returned to them after finalization of the contract under intimation and against acknowledgement from the Bidders.

5.GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS (GTC):

A. Terms & conditions governing the bid as follows:

- i) The Bidders, or their authorized representatives, would be permitted to attend the opening of the Tenders. The representatives must carry a letter of authority or any other valid document from the bidders, authorizing them to attend the tender opening, failing to which they will not be permitted to participate in this process.
- ii) Unsigned Bids are liable to be rejected.
- iii) The Bids should be neatly presented. Corrections, if any, should be duly authenticated with full signature of the person who has signed the Bids, failing which such Bids are liable to be rejected.
- iv) AIESL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all offers without assigning any reason.
- v) In the event of default in services, AIESL reserves the right to cancel the order and to claim damages from the successful tenderer, and also reserves the right to award the contract to another vendor at the cost and risk of the successful bidder.

B. DEFINITIONS

- ii) "Goods" or "Items" shall mean all of the equipment including their accessories and /or other materials, which the Tenderer is required to supply to the Purchaser under the contract.

- iv) "Seller" or "Bidder" means the individual or firm or company, who are manufacturers and suppliers, on whom the order for work is placed and shall be deemed to include their approved successors, heirs, executors and administrators, holding company/Group/Group Companies, Conglomerate as the case may be.
- v) "AIESL representative" means the authorized representative of the purchaser.
- vi) "Manufacturer" means original equipment manufacturer (OEM). "Vendor "means contractor/supplier to the Bidder.

C. PENALTY CLAUSE:

(Non Compliance on Penalty clause terms will lead to disqualification):-

Prompt, Punctual, Efficient, Safe, Courteous And Quality Service Is The Essence Of This Po. In case of failure on the part of the service provider to comply with any one or more of the terms of the PO, the applicable penalty clauses listed below shall be invoked.

0.5% of the PO value per week to a maximum of 10% of the total value will be levied for non-completion of satisfactory performance of the work within the stipulated time period.

D. PRICE NEGOTIATION:

As it is not the general norm for AIESL to carry out price negotiations following evaluation of the bids (RFQ), the bidders are advised to submit their best quotes in response to this tender. However, AIESL, reserves the right to carry out negotiations in exceptional cases with the bidder who has been evaluated by AIESL as having offered the lowest bid in response to the tender.

E. VALIDITY OF PRICES:

Quotations should be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of technical bids.

F. EXIT CLAUSE/TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT:

The service provider shall undertake that in the event of failure to complete the job within

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the time and according to the requirement and the terms & conditions of the PO, the PO will be liable for cancellation and services will be obtained from other sources on account and at the cost of service provider. The service provider will be fully responsible for any difference in rate and other expenses arising out of such alternate arrangements.

G. AIESL'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT/ REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

AIESL reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to cancel the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to the award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders. However, the Bidder(s) who wish to seek reasons for such decision of cancellation/rejection shall be informed of the same by AIESL unless its disclosure reasonably could be expected to affect the sovereignty and integrity of India, the security, strategic, scientific, or economic interest of the state or lead to incitement of an offence.

The bidder whose bid has been accepted will be notified of the award by AIESL prior to expiration of the Bid validity period through the "Letter of Acceptance/ Letter of Award", which will state the sum that AIESL will pay to the Contractor in consideration of the execution, completion by the Contractor as prescribed by the Contract.

The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract until the Formal Agreement is signed. The successful bidder shall execute Contract Agreement and sign the Integrity Pact (wherever applicable) with AIESL on non-judicial paper of appropriate value as per Stamp Act in the format appended within 28 days from the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance/ Letter of Award.

H. REJECTION OF BIDS:

The response to the Bidder (RFQ) will be rejected forthwith without evaluation of the tender response on the following grounds:

- i. If the Bidder have been received after due date and time of closing of the tender.
- ii. If the RFQ/BID have been received by fax or email.
- iii. If the RFQ/BID have been received unsigned.
- iv. If the RFQ/BID has been received in an open condition.
- v. The Bidder should ensure that: -
 - The bid document should be neatly typed and signed on numbered pages filed inbinding folder.
 - Corrections/over writing, if any, should be duly authenticated with full signature of the person who is signing the tender (initials will not be accepted).

I. ZERO DEVIATION

Bidder is advised to quote strictly as per terms and conditions of tender document and not to stipulate any deviation / exceptions / conditions. This is a zero deviation tender.

Bidder to note that taking deviation to following clauses of tender documents shall lead to rejection of their bids:

- i. Firm Price and award criteria
- ii. EMD
- iii. Scope of Work
- iv. Special Conditions of Purchase order
- v. Delivery Schedule strictly before 1400 hrs within 60Days from award of contract.
- vi. Period of Validity of Bid 120Days

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- vii. Performance Bank Guarantee / Security Deposit
- viii. Guarantee of work / Services / equipment
 - ix. Arbitration / Resolution of Dispute
 - x. Force Majeure
 - xi. Statutory Compliance to Applicable Laws
- xii. Any other condition specifically mentioned in the tender documents elsewhere that non-compliance of the clause shall lead to rejection of the bid.

J. ARBITRATION:

Any dispute arising between the parties in respect of the construction, interpretation, application, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this document or the validity or breach thereof, shall first be settled by mutual consultation. If the dispute remains unresolved after a period of 90 days from the date when the mutual consultation has started, the matter shall be referred for settlement to 'SCOPE FORUM OF CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION', Govt. of India, and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties

K. FRAUDULENT PRACTICES:

AIESL requires that Bidders observe the highest standard of ethics during the Bidding process and execution of contracts. In pursuance of this, AIESL defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

- a) "Corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- b) "Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts to influence a procurement process, or the execution of a contract deemed to be detrimental to AIESL and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive AIESL of the benefits of free and open competition.
- c) EMD or Security deposit shall be forfeited in addition to the above-mentioned remedies which AIESL shall have taken.

L. BLACK LISTING CONDITIONS:

The party shall be black listed from participating in any AIESL tenders for next three years in case adopts fraudulent practices as cited above in clause and against errant bidders as specified in clause. Withdraws after award of the Purchase order / Letter Of Award (LOA) and fails to commence within the specified stipulated period and perform the contractual obligations during the currency of the Purchase order.

M. <u>INTERPRETATION OF AMBIGUITY</u>:

N. FORCE MAJEURE:

Neither party shall be liable for delay in performing obligations or for failure to perform obligations if the delay results from any of the following (whether happening in India or

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elsewhere) force majeure, Act of God or any Governmental act, fire, earthquake, explosion, accident, industrial dispute, civil commotion, or anything beyond the control of either party. The party shall use all reasonable endeavors to minimize any such delay. Upon cessation of the event giving rise to the delay the parties shall in so far as may be practicable under the circumstance

O. JURISDICTION:



Total 4 ceiling Fans and 6 Industrial Coolers




INDUSTRIAL COOLER INSTALLATION LOCATIONS (TOP VIEW) Drawing No.3
